

DIRECTIONS:

Do NOT dilute or use additives of any kind.

Dispensing: Use a pump-up or compressed air sprayer and dispense with a coarse, wet spray. Do NOT spray as a mist.

Ice Prevention: Use 1 gallon of **Liquid Ice Melt** per 3300 square feet. Use more when expecting freezing rain.

Ice Removal: Score the ice with some type of rake/blade to allow product to get under ice sheet. Use 1 gallon of **Liquid Ice Melt** per 550 square feet. Use more if the ice is thicker than 1/2 inch. Use a broom to sweep away ice.
